Characters of green apple and ripe pear carry forth a lush and round mouth feel.

Crisp and dry with aromatics of peach, pear, and a light floral note balanced by the fresh acidity provided by our cool climate. Stainless steel fermented and aged with minimal lees contact to preserve purity of fruit.
